This is also the time of year that home burglaries increase. By following these few simple guidelines you can make your home less of an inviting target.

- Talk to your trusted neighbors, let them know your plans and ask them to watch your home while you're away.
- Stop by our department and request that your home be placed on a house watch list. This requires an officer to check your home at least once a day while you're away.
- Buy some timer controls and set them to turn lights on and off in your home at different times, making it appear that someone is at home.
- Stop your mail and newspapers while you're away so they don't build up and advertise that no one is home.

Tips from the Fire Department: Please be aware that with the colder weather you always need to have your chimney inspected and cleaned by a professional before using. Also, anyone who uses a portable heater inside their home should only use products that are UL listed. Keep all combustibles at least three feet away from any heater. Finally, any citizens that display live Christmas trees should make sure that they properly water the tree to prevent a fire hazard.

Holiday Trash: Due to the Thanksgiving Holiday on Thursday, November 24th, trash scheduled to be picked up on 24th will be picked up on Wednesday, November 23rd.

Water: Winter is coming! To help prevent your pipes from freezing, you can insulate any exposed pipes, cover or wrap exposed hose bibs, leave cabinet doors open under your sinks so warm air can circulate under the sinks and leave a faucet open with a slow drip.

Wastewater: Please do not dispose of cooking oils down your drains. They can solidify either in your private sewer service or in the City mains, which can cause stoppage and overflows. A stoppage to your service line can cost you money. A stoppage on the City main will not only cost the City money, but it will also affect the treatment process at the Wastewater Treatment Plant. You can dispose of up to 5 gallons of cooking oil at the Coweta Recycling Center located at 1160 S 265th E Ave.
