

In order to provide additional funding for the \$15,299,434 Water Treatment Facility upgrades, as a result of the requirements mandated by the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality, as well as provide necessary funding to maintain public infrastructure, a 2.1% Environmental Compliance Adjustment will be enacted on the base rates for water, sewer and garbage fees, beginning with the July 1, 2013 billing cycle.
