YOUR NEW WATER PLANT IS NOW UNDER CONSTRUCTION!



A multi-million dollar state-of-the-art water treatment plant is currently under construction. The new water plant will meet and exceed current federal clean water standards as well as anticipate for future requirements. The City of Coweta has been working on improvements to its water treatment process for many years including a new disinfection basin, a chemical feed building, two 500,000 gallon ground tanks and a high service pump station, all of which were installed in 2008. In 2010, the City made distribution system

improvements to include a secondary main transmission line to the Skyview Tower, which has provided better water pressure to the community. A new pump station was also installed at the Skyview tower. Through all of this, the City has worked with the Department of Environmental Quality to ensure compliance with state and federal requirements. This is the biggest upgrade to the water plant in 20 years. The new plant's capacity and technology is expected to meet the City's water



needs until the year 2035. The new plant also will feature some new technology that has never been used in the state of Oklahoma, although it has been used in other places and has done very well. The existing water plant can pump as much as 2.3 million gallons of water per day, the new plant will be able to pump as much as 4 million gallons at peak capacity. Construction of the plant is expected to be substantially complete by late this year.
