

ORDINANCE NO. 754

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING THE CITY OF COWETA, OKLAHOMA'S, SEAT BELTS AND CHILD PASSENGER RESTRAINTS REQUIRED ORDINANCE AT SECTION 15-556 OF THE COWETA CODE OF ORDINANCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Coweta's current ordinance concerning Seat Belts and Child Passenger Restraints Required at Section 15-556 is not entirely consistent with recent changes in state statutes; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Coweta has adopted the state traffic code at title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and by doing so has incorporated state traffic offenses into the City Code of Ordinances; and,

WHEREAS, repeal of Section 15-556 of the Coweta Code of Ordinances will allow the City to enforce the state traffic code section dealing with Seat Belts and Child Passenger Restraints, including those changes that may occur as a result of new state legislation.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COWETA, OKLAHOMA, THAT:

Section One: Section 15-556 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Coweta is hereby repealed.

Section Two: By separate vote, the Coweta City Council determines an emergency exists and that this ordinance shall be effective upon approval and publication.
