



## ORDINANCE NO. 763

**AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN CONTIGUOUS TRACTS OF LAND FORMING A PART OF SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 17 NORTH, RANGE 16 EAST OF THE INDIAN MERIDIAN IN WAGONER COUNTY, OKLAHOMA; PROVIDING FOR ZONING CLASSIFICATION; MAKING ALL OF SAID TERRITORY A PART OF WARD 3 OF THE CITY OF COWETA, OKLAHOMA; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COWETA

**Section 1.** That the following described tracts of land lying contiguous to the present corporate limits of the City of Coweta, to wit:

*A Parcel of land known as the Koweta Cemetery described as: The North 270 feet of the South 527.1 feet of the west 610 feet of the southeast (SE1/4) quarter of Section 19, Township 17 North, Range 16 East, Wagoner County Oklahoma*

**Section 2.** The City Council of the City of Coweta, Oklahoma, finds the above described tract of land adjacent to or contiguous to property already within the municipal limits of said City of Coweta.

**Section 3.** That the above described property is currently zoned under Wagoner County designations and shall be zoned to the City of Coweta's zoning district AG (Agricultural) classifications.

**Section 4.** That the above described property shall be part of the City Council Ward 3 boundary of the City of Coweta.

**Section 5.** That the required Service Plan is attached and deemed a part of this ordinance.

**Section 6.** That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

**Section 7.** That if any parts hereof be held invalid or ineffective, the remaining portions shall not be affected but remain in full force and effect.


**Section 8.** That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, and therefore that this ordinance shall become effective from and after the time of its passage and approval.
