Re: Metal Building and Concrete
Date: July 6, 2022

BACKGROUND

The white building at 104 W Chestnut is currently being used by the Coweta Police department, Coweta Fire Department and Coweta Public Works for storage. This building is due to be demolished within the next 2 months. The Coweta Police Department is asking to have a 20'x 20' x 8' foot metal building be placed inside the fence of the animal control shelter to provide storage space to be used by all City Departments.

BENEFITS

This will provide a cost-effective secure space for storage that can be utilized by several City departments well into the future.

COSTS

The concrete cost for a 20'x20' pad is \$9,950. The installed cost for the 20'x20'x8' metal building will be \$5330.00. The total cost for the project is \$15,280.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Council motion authorizing the construction of a new metal building and the concrete.
